Cornwall Councillor update for Probus 22/2/24

20mph and A390.

You will have noticed now that some works have started on the 20mph limit in Probus. So far this has been removal of white line road signage and erecting of poles for the new 20mph signage. I met with Adam O'Neill yesterday to discuss the progress and some parts of the new limit will be introduced over the new few weeks although not all.

The traffic calming measures are still being re-drawn and are currently with the Road Safety Team, as previously reported. However, he does expect these to be ready sometime in March and he will share these with me asap, I will, of course, share them with the Parish Clerk asap.

It is likely that the traffic calming measures will be built in May.

I wanted to also just update following some residents concerns raised with me recently following the accident at the Trevorva junction A390. When there is an accident on that junction residents have two concerns, the impact of the closure of the bypass on the village and that there should be further road safety measures implemented at the junction. I do, of course, share these.

I have asked for a Road Safety review of the bypass as the last was undertaken in February 2021. I have received a response from Viv Bidgood, Highways Manager as below:

I understand the most up-to-date accident site listing is being compiled and will be issued shortly, so we will be able to understand where this junction sits in the overall scheme of things shortly. I will provide an update when the list has been issued.

I will continue to pursue all options once the accident site listing is completed and will keep you informed.

Waste Collection

Most of Probus will see their new bins arrive, as part of the new waste collection service, in January 2025. A small number of streets in the village, The Green for instance have received theirs already due to the different collection routes.

Surface Strips in the Square
