

## **Report from Cornwall Councillor Glasson for Probus Parish Council meeting 18<sup>th</sup> July 2024**

### Traffic Calming and 20mph

I have asked Adam O'Neill why the build out in West End hasn't been completed and his response is:

The latest is that National Grid didn't turn up when they were originally scheduled to do so and therefore a priority system was left in place to ensure the work area was safe. National Grid have returned to do their element of the work in that area this week and the Cormac team will complete the work on the northern side. The works on the south will be done at the beginning of August (when National Grid have scheduled their next visit).

The 20mph is enforceable from Monday 22 July, in line with all 20mph roads in the Roseland Truro network area.

### Community Levelling Up Funding

Excellent news that the grant funding has now come through for both the Village Hall and the Church. An Incredible amount of investment into Probus by the Council (from Previous Government funding)

### Denas Water junction

I have reported the grass verges at Denas Water as I am concerned about the visibility and hope these will be cut soon.

### Parking enforcement

I have again reported the inconsiderate parking again on the yellow lines at Chapel Street. Parking here makes it incredibly difficult for walkers and drivers at the junction and I will keep requesting enforcement. They do come out but not regularly enough.

### Wildanet

I have again reported the uneven block paving at Cullen View and will continue to do so until this is fully repaired.
