

## **Report from Cornwall Cllr Karen Glasson, dd. 12<sup>th</sup> May 2024**

I have spoken to Tredenham Trust about their concerns with the traffic calming and been reassured by Adam O'Neill that the buildout will not impact the allotment entrance.

I have also got agreement for a drop kerb to be placed outside the garage, as per a request from the garage owners and a resident. This should make this easier for wheelchairs users and unloading for the garage.

Obviously, I have chased the remedial works for the square as mentioned.

I am speaking regularly with the Streetworks Inspector to ensure the roads and paths dug up by Wildanet and other utilities recently are repaired fully. He has assured me that this will be done.

Also if anything would like to discuss anything with the Leader of the Council, Cllr Linda Taylor, she is doing a series of events, next one for Roseland and Truro is 11 June at 7pm, Long Gallery, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY. Everyone is welcome to attend.
